The purpose of the investigation has been to understand the nature of flooding along the creek, including understanding the impact of channel decommissioning. Secondly, it has investigated ways to reduce the impact of future floods.

A community steering committee oversaw this project, which was managed by Wimmera CMA in partnership with Yarriambiack, Northern Grampians and Buloke Shire Councils along with GWMWater. Experienced consultants Water Technology have helped with the investigation.

It covers the catchment of Dunmunkle Creek, which is around 90 kilometres end to end from its offtake on the Wimmera River near Glenorchy to north of Carron.
